



Eifel German Rye Malt Whisky

Released in 2018, only 1200 bottles of the original US bottling of Eifel German Rye Whisky were produced. This whisky was distilled from 90% locally grown German rye, and 10% unpeated malted barley. Distillation was done in the German tradition: a primary distillation in a column still (including the grist), followed by a second distillation in a small copper pot still. The alcohol content is reduced to 60% before entering casks. The spirit was initially aged for one year in heavily toasted new and refill casks with interchanging oak and acacia staves, an additional two years in refill American oak casks, which previously were used to age red Bordeaux wines. Finally, the whisky rests in German casks which previously held German Pinot Noir, and were emptied only a few hours before the spirit enters the casks. Eifel German Rye Whisky earned a 96 Point rating and the Liquid Gold Award from Jim Murray's Whisky Bible.
