

Teerenpeli PYYGIN

Teerenpeli PyyGin is a fantastically unique gin distilled from a base of 40% wheat and 60% barley. PyyGin is named in honor of Teerenpeli's founder, Mr. Anssi Pyysing. This spirit is blended with local water, which was filtered through the Salpausselkä esker, a gravel ridge formed by the ice age about 10,000 years ago. Eight botanicals (juniper berries, lingonberries, amarillo aroma hops, lemon peel, coriander seeds, cumin, licorice roots, and cinnamon) are then added to the spirit to macerate for 24 hours. This is then distilled in Teerenpeli's pot still and blended with the same filtered water to reach the desired abv of 45%. All eight of the botanicals either come from Finland or nearby Belgium. The result is an incredible gin which is the perfect backbone for a classic martini. Teerenpeli's PyyGin was awarded 91 Points by the Ultimate Spirits Challenge.
